  - o Reading (Suggested: Esther 4:17 (Lect. III, p 544)
  - Hymn or Psalm
  - Gospel Reading (Suggested: Matt 10:26-33)
- #RedWednesday Message (See #RedWednesday Starter Pack)
- Silent Prayer
- Hymn of Petition
- Intercessions (You might like to ask a member of each visiting church to offer an
  intercession on a specific theme; these might include refugees and displaced people,
  those who are punished for maintaining their beliefs, those who have lost friends
  and families because of religious persecution, those are not free to express their
  faith, those who have died for their faith)
- Final Prayer
- Blessing
- Final Hymn of Praise
