# Chapter 6:

# Today, we are going to learn how to make our own altar at home!

- 1. Watch the video where Clara describes the altar that she and her family have made: https://youtu.be/EwN6-btykDs
- 2. Gather together some of the holy items which you have at home. If you don't have any of your own at home, then you can use your creativity to make/draw some items/pictures. If you have a candle or two, these can also be added. When we light a candle, even that action can be part of our prayer. (Remember to ask an adult to help if you want to light a candle.)
- 3. Create your altar! It's really that simple. Place the items on a clear space of some kind. Bridget's altar (pictured above) is on top of her fireplace, but you can place it wherever you have some room.
- 4. Now you can come to your altar whenever you want to say a prayer. Obviously, we can pray wherever we may be, but having these things to concentrate on can make it a little easier to focus on our prayer time.



Prayer for today: Lord, you have chosen a vocation for my life; a special task that you have not given to anyone else. Help me to be courageous in discovering my life's purpose. Like Abraham, may I trust in your plan for me.



# Chapter 7:

Scribes were responsible for copying out ancient texts onto the scrolls that made up the Old Testament books. Their work was a prayer and was painstakingly precise. Every letter had to be measured, counted and checked to make sure it was accurate.

God Speaks to his Children, the ACN Child's Bible, is sometimes the only book a child will ever own. It has been used since its release in 1979 to teach children about their Christian faith and to provide an invaluable literacy tool as well!. To date, over 51 million copies in 190 languages have gone out around the world. The edition in Spanish is the most popular (around 14 million copies printed), with Portuguese not far behind (10.3 million). English (2.5 million), French (1.2 million) and Swahili (950,000) are the next most popular languages.

From the very beginning, ACN has distributed God Speaks to his Children to struggling Christian communities free of charge. For every copy sold in the UK, 3 more copies will be sent out to children elsewhere for free.
