



# You will need: 1 square piece of paper A pair of scissors






Step 1:

Fold the square of paper in half. Make sure to press down on the crease.

Step 2:

Fold the bottom right corner of the paper up towards the centre of the top of the paper, in a triangle shape.





### Step 3:

Unfold the triangle to reveal a line like the one pictured.


### Step 4:



Fold the top right corner down towards the bottom of the paper in a triangle shape.










### Step 5:

Unfold the triangle to reveal a shape like the one pictured.

### Step 6:


Bring the point of the bottom left corner to the middle of the shape you have formed on the right hand side of the paper







### Step 7:


Turn the paper anti-clockwise, so it is in the same position as pictured.

















**Step 10:** 

Flip your shape onto the opposite side.




**Step 11:** 

Fold the shorter edge up, towards the long edge, creating a triangle shape.

**Step 12:** 

Your shape should look something like this!






### **Step 13:**

Hold your shape with the pointed end, pointing away from you. Carefully cut the section as shown in the image.








**Step 14:** 

When cut, you should be left with a small triangle shape like this






**Step 15:** 

Unfold your shape to reveal the star!



Apply a gentle crease to each of the five points of the star.
