Children's Rosary - Joyful Mysteries

Day 1: The Annunciation – Mary conceives by the Holy Spirit

The Archangel Gabriel was sent by God to Mary in Nazareth to ask her if she would be the Mother of Jesus. He told her that God himself would be the Father of this Child.

Mary believed that God could do anything and so she said “yes”.

Mary, Mother of God, we pray to you to grant us your faith, so that we may learn from you how to always listen to God and do whatever he asks of us.

Day 2: The visitation – Mary with her unborn baby Jesus visits her cousin Elizabeth

The angel Gabriel had also told Mary that her cousin Elizabeth was expecting a baby, so Mary set out at once to see her and help her. As soon as they said hello, Elizabeth felt her own baby kick happily in her tummy. The Holy Spirit helped Elizabeth to know that Mary was going to be the Mother of God. Elizabeth cried with joy and said “you are blessed Mary because you have believed.”

Mary, Mother of God we beg you to pray for all missionaries who work to bring God to other people. May they find open hearts, ready to welcome the message of Jesus with joy and believe in him.

Day 3: The Nativity – Mary gives birth to Jesus in Bethlehem

When Mary and Joseph got to Bethlehem, they were forced to sleep in a stable. Joseph tried to find them a place to stay but, there was no room for them in the Inn. So that is where the baby Jesus was born. The first people to come and see and worship the Holy Child were shepherds. Angels told them that the Saviour, the Messiah was born.

Mary Mother of God, we ask you to pray for all

children and families who have nowhere to live, people who have lost their homes through war and natural disasters. Send them kind people to care for them and bring them peace from God.

Day 4: The Presentation in the Temple – Mary takes Jesus to the house of God

Jewish Law says that every child must be taken to the Temple 40 days after they are born. When Mary and Joseph took the baby Jesus to the Temple, they met an old and holy man called Simeon. The Holy Spirit helped Simeon recognise that Jesus was the son of God. Simeon then held Jesus lovingly in his arms and declared: “My eyes have seen salvation.” This old man understood that Jesus had come to save us all from sin.

Jesus we pray to you for all those people who do not yet know you. Give them the grace and opportunity to hear about you and understand that you alone are the Light and Salvation of the world.

Day 5: The finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple

When Jesus was about 12, he went with his parents to the Temple in Jerusalem to celebrate the Feast of Passover. He stayed behind afterwards, talking to the learned scholars about God, his own Father. Meanwhile Mary and Joseph had already set off home and suddenly realised that Jesus was not with them. In a panic they returned to Jerusalem to search for him. Eventually they found him. He was still in the Temple.

Divine Father, we pray to you for all parents who have lost their children, or who are worried about their children, and for those expecting a child who are worried about the future. Help them to trust in you and know that you are with them in every situation.
