DESIGN YOUR OWN INFOGRAPHIC TO DEPICT ACN'S MOBILE PHONE CHALLENGE

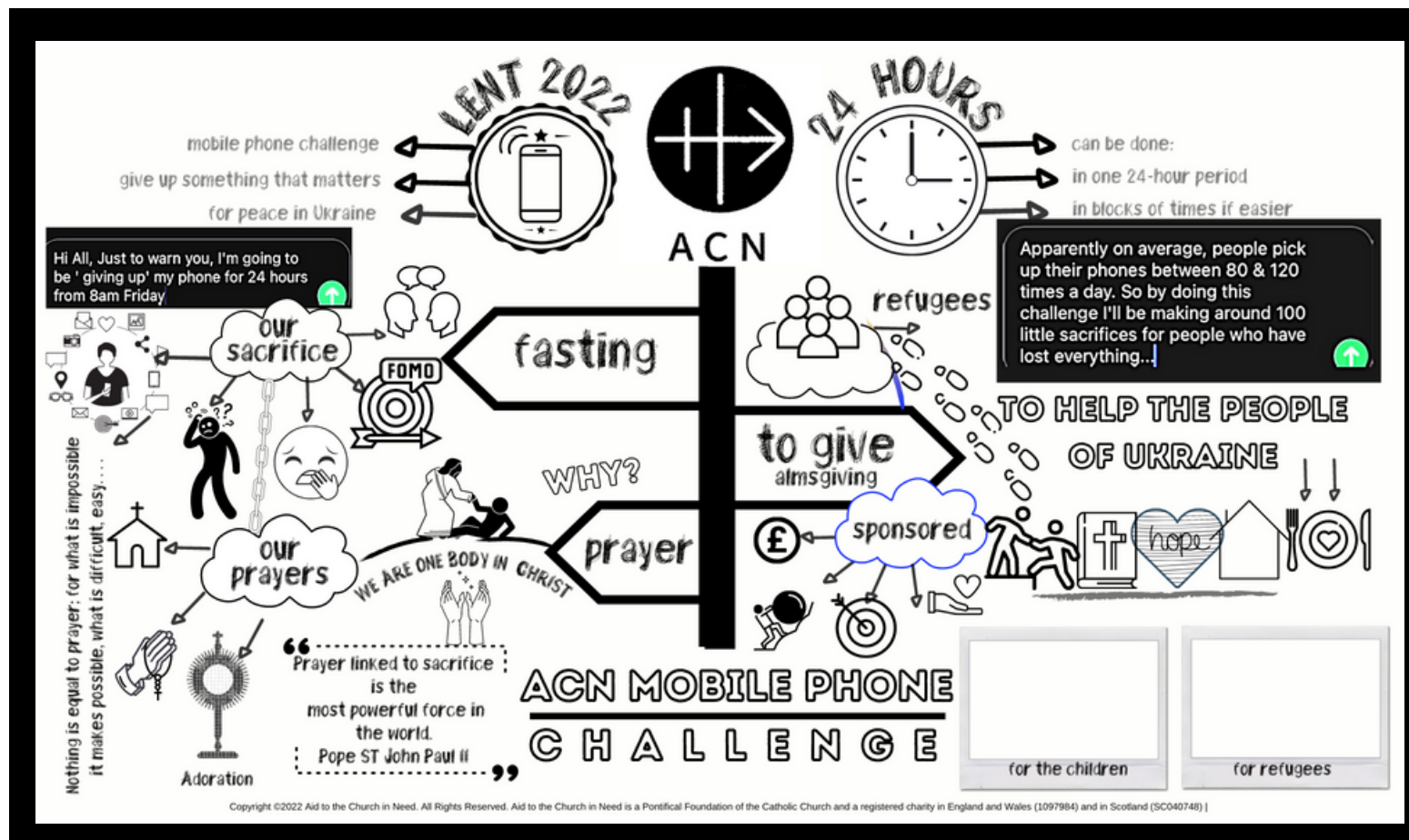
(Option1)

3. Plan how best to show the information. Ask yourself the following questions:

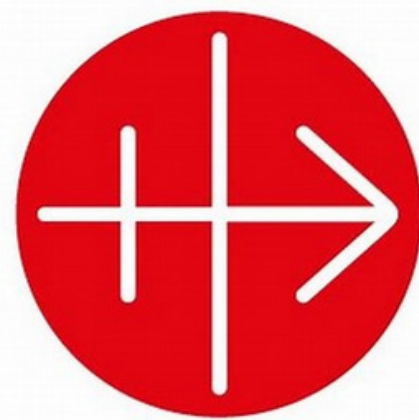
What do I need? What can I leave out? How can I convey emotion and meaning? Does it make sense? Does each section link together? Can I find a way to make the viewer want to find out more?

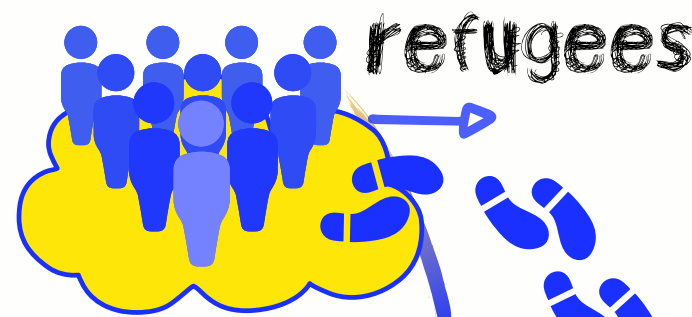

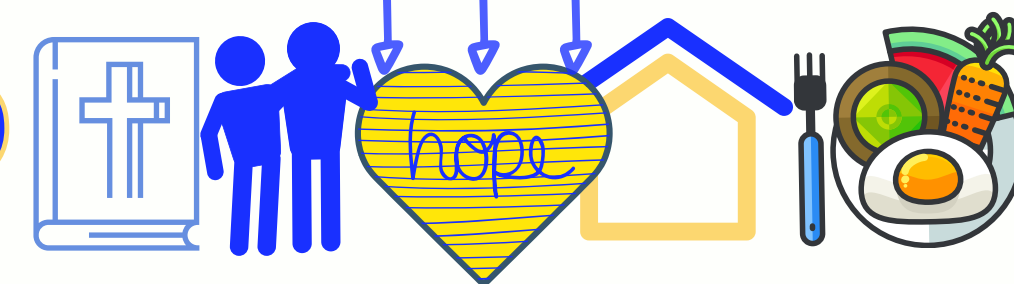
