Roman said: "The house caught fire and all the windows were blown out." Maira, a Christian girl in Pakistan, is in mortal danger after escaping from a Muslim man. Maira was kidnapped, gangraped, blackmailed and her abductor forced her to convert and marry him. She was 14 years-old when she suffered this terrible ordeal and has been in hiding after escaping her captors. Maira told ACN: "Please get us out...we believe in God and that you can help us get out of here." For more than two years, ACN has been lobbying the UK Government for action in Maira's case but, as vet, without

Fr Andrew was saying Mass on Pentecost Sunday in 2022 when gunmen opened fire at St Francis Xavier's Catholic Church in Ondo, Nigeria, 41 people were killed and more than 70 were injured including children. Christians in Nigeria are often persecuted for their faith and live in fear of violence from Islamist militants. Priests are frequently called to pray and comfort their flock in times of suffering, but they too need our prayers. Fr Andrew said: "I shielded them just like a hen shields her chicks..." ACN is supporting the faithful in Nigeria with trauma counselling.
